

## **MINSTER CENTRE TRAINEE APPRENTICESHIP SCHEME**

The Minster Centre is introducing an apprenticeship scheme for qualified practitioners who wish to gain experience as trainers/tutors.

You will need to be qualified to MA level, registered with the UKCP, and not a current student at The Minster Centre. This means that you need to have successfully completed all aspects of your training.

Successful applicants will assist in seminars and exercises, be given the opportunity to work with more than one tutor, see how assessment is carried out and be welcome to attend year group meetings. Attendance at meetings is not a requirement.

These will be an unpaid positions but we will offer travel reimbursement plus the opportunity to attend some of our CPD events for no or reduced cost.

### **Requirements include:**

A sound theoretical knowledge of integrative approaches that are taught across the programmes.

The ability to apply theory to skills practice.

Experience of working with groups.

The ability to be involved in assessment of students, which includes excellent verbal and written communication skills.

A commitment to attending all required seminars, relevant to the position, for the duration of the academic year or the full extent of the module, as appropriate.

A willingness to familiarise yourself with the Programme Handbooks and Aids to Study.

The ability to work in a team and foster good working relationships.

We are looking to recruit 4 assistants to work alongside tutors in Year 1 Skills Seminars, which take place on Tuesdays from 12-2.30 or 3.30 – 6pm, starting 26 September 2017.
