## **SUPERVISION OF COUNSELLORS IN IAPT**

The aim of this workshop, ***for qualified counsellors and psychotherapists only***, will be to explore some of the dilemmas of supervising in an organisational context by presentation and discussion of the challenges and opportunities of supervising counsellors in an IAPT service. Issues covered will include working to Key Performance Indicators, equity vs individual needs (patients and therapists), different types of supervision (including role conflict, line management, case management, reflective space, authority/responsibility), complexity of presentations and liaison with other services, and alternative models for provision of supervision in this context.

**Gill Smith** has led a Counselling Team in an IAPT service for 4 years. She is an Integrative Psychotherapist with extensive experience of working as a Counsellor, Psychotherapist and Supervisor in NHS Primary Care and other settings. She began working as a Counsellor in a GP practice in 1993 and has witnessed the changes in the provision of NHS mental health services as IAPT has developed.
