## Diploma in Integrative Supervision

- Runs at weekends over 6 months beginning January 2018.

- Topics include contracting, ethics, issues of difference, assessment and focusing, developmental stages, unconscious relational processes, the internal supervisor, issues of power and authority, ruptures in the supervisory alliance, the organisational context, and working with groups.
- Counts towards CPD.
- It is possible to do additional elements to obtain a PG Dip/MA.

## DPgD/MA in Professional Practice (Supervision)

- A further year includes research components and a dissertation leading to a PgD or MA, validated by Middlesex University.
