One of the aims of integrative supervision is the exploration and making sense of the client's transference and the therapist's countertransference. Supervision training teaches us that supervision is not therapy. Supervisors are warned about the pitfalls of turning the supervisory relationship into a therapeutic one. It is a reality, however, that transference dynamics do arise within the supervisory relationship itself. Such dynamics are often hard to identify and stay hidden within the unconscious dynamics between therapist and client. If not addressed, transference can undermine the supervisory relationship and may have a knock on effect on therapists' work with their clients.

This workshop will be primarily experiential and will be examining how we can navigate this fine line between therapy and supervision without ignoring the transference and without engaging in working with it therapeutically. ***This workshop is for qualified practitioners only.***

**Sophia Prevezanou** is a UKCP Registered Transpersonal Psychotherapist originally trained in psychosynthesis. She is an integrative supervisor, with experience in the charity sector and in private practice. Alongside her clinical and supervision practice, she is a trainer at the Psychosynthesis Trust and The Minster Centre.
